

Stanley Park 125th Anniversary Car Show

Location: Stanley Park - "Devonian Park" north of Georgia St / west of Denman

Time: August 24 – 25 – nominally noon until late afternoon

The Vancouver chapter of VCCC has recently (very recently) been approach by the Stanley Park 125th Anniversary Committee to gauge our willingness to organize and participate in this two day event. Peter Trant, the Vancouver VCCC contact person, has met with the event organizers and has walked the site.

The Event

A car show on the grassy and now hard dry surface of Devonian Park immediately north of Georgia Street, and just west of the parking lot off Denman St. They would like to have car displays on both Saturday and Sunday from noon to late afternoon, but with in-out privileges. Although the Vancouver chapter of VCCC has a large membership, it is not reasonable to believe that we could adequately occupy this site by ourselves, so we are sending this notice to all of the lower mainland "car" clubs, to see if you are willing to participate as well.

Although the site is quite large, and there is little likelihood of an overflow, we would a representative of each of the clubs let me know about how many cars you would expect to provide, and the number on each of the two days Because of the short timeframe we may have to place cars as they arrive and not by club or manufacturer. However, if the clubs can provide sufficient "parking attendants" and if we know how many cars to expect, we could set aside "blocks".

If you were planning on visiting Stanley Park for the 125th Anniversary in any case, the Car Show will be an opportunity for free parking.

Not all of the details have been worked out as yet, but as we get closer to the event this memo will be updated and sent to the designated contact person from each participating club. If we have a large response for show cars, we will need parking volunteers.

Totem A&T and North Shore Rod and Custom are having their 12th annual car show near the North Vancouver Automall on the 25th, so please be mindful of that before making a Stanley Park commitment on that date.

Hollow Tree Photo Display

The Stanley Park Event organizers are quite enthusiastic about our suggestion to have a display of

Hollow Tree" / Stanley Park photos. Because they expect the park to be congested with an estimated

11,000 visitors/per day, the display will be at the car show site, and not at the Hollow Tree.

The Vancouver chapter of VCCC has a large stick pin type display board on which we will attach photos

as follows: Hollow Tree with vehicles and/or people, and general interest vehicle photos throughout the

Park, up to the present time.

If you have any personal photos (photocopies will be OK), they or your contact information, would be a welcome addition. We will get the message out through Stanley Park social media so that the public can have the opportunity to participate as well.
