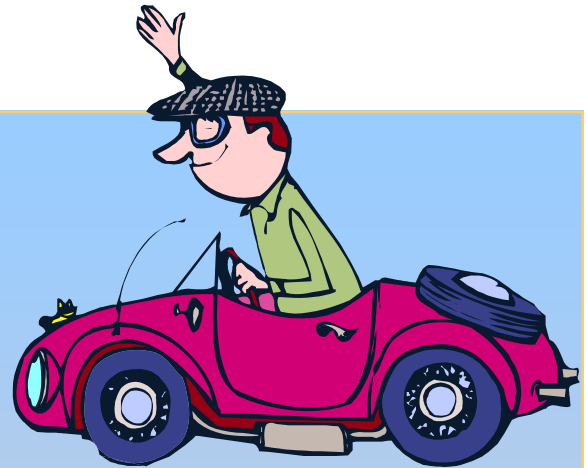
The August 10, 2009 Membership meeting will be held in Rainbow Station at the Burnaby Model Railway.
